 - Being involved with community projects OR
 - By creating job opportunities OR

- Have to be a citizen of Mangaung in the year of nomination
- You can be a member of an organization, but nominees must not only be nominated for doing their work – they must be exceptional at their job, or it must not be their job
- There is no age restrictions

Who can nominate? Anyone, so long the person that is being nominated are willing to accept the nomination and sign the application form. All nominees must be available if required on 5 October and 15 October 2016. You cannot nominate yourself.
